Event Name: Awareness poster against COVID-19

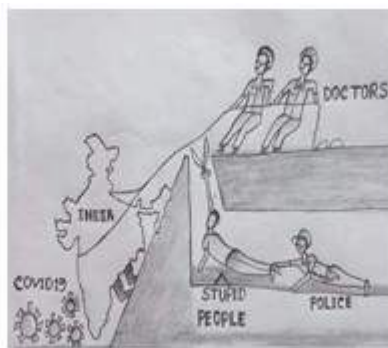
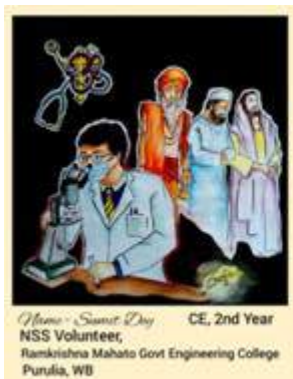
Type: Online

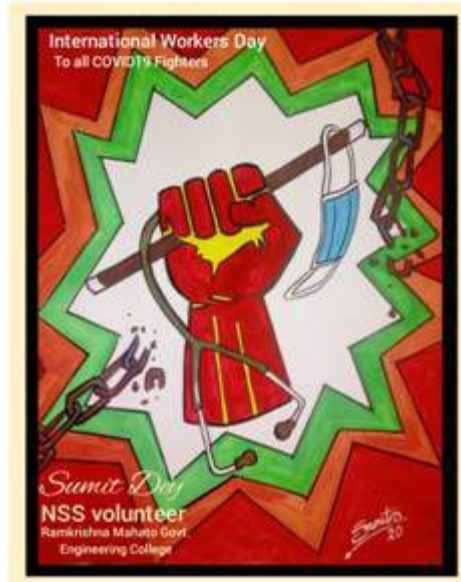
Event Name: International Workers' Day.

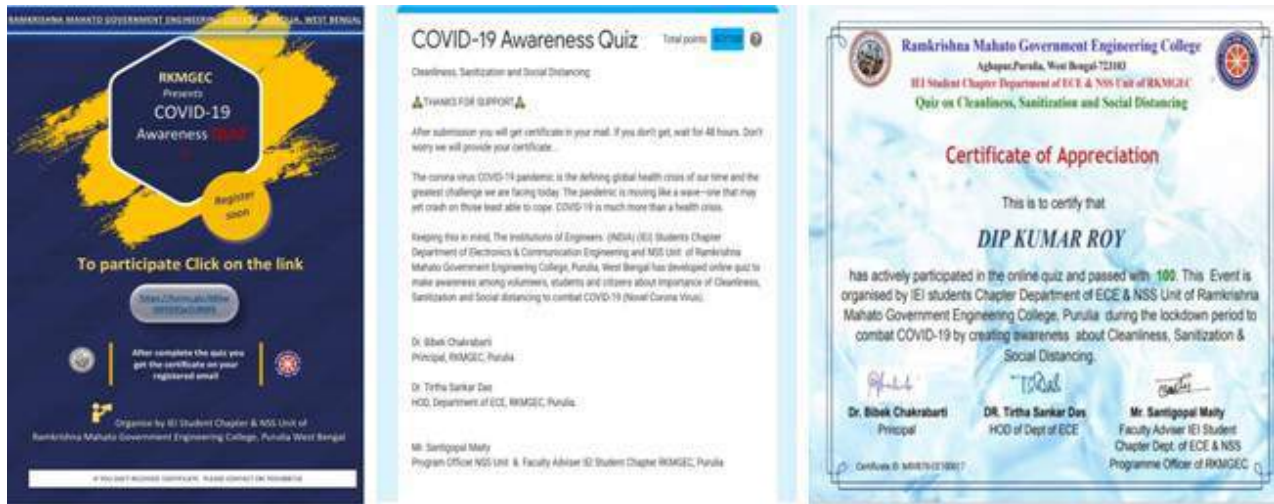
Event Name: COVID-19 Awareness Quiz.

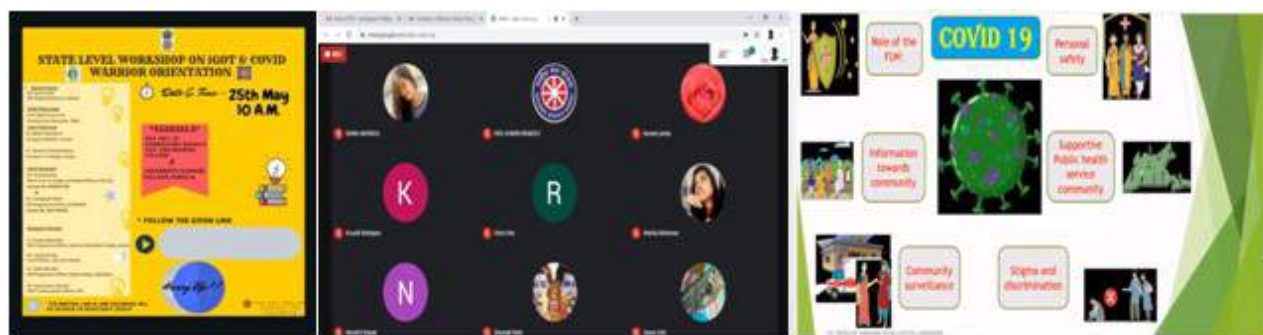


Event Name: Sate Level Workshop on IGOT & COVID Warrior Orientation.

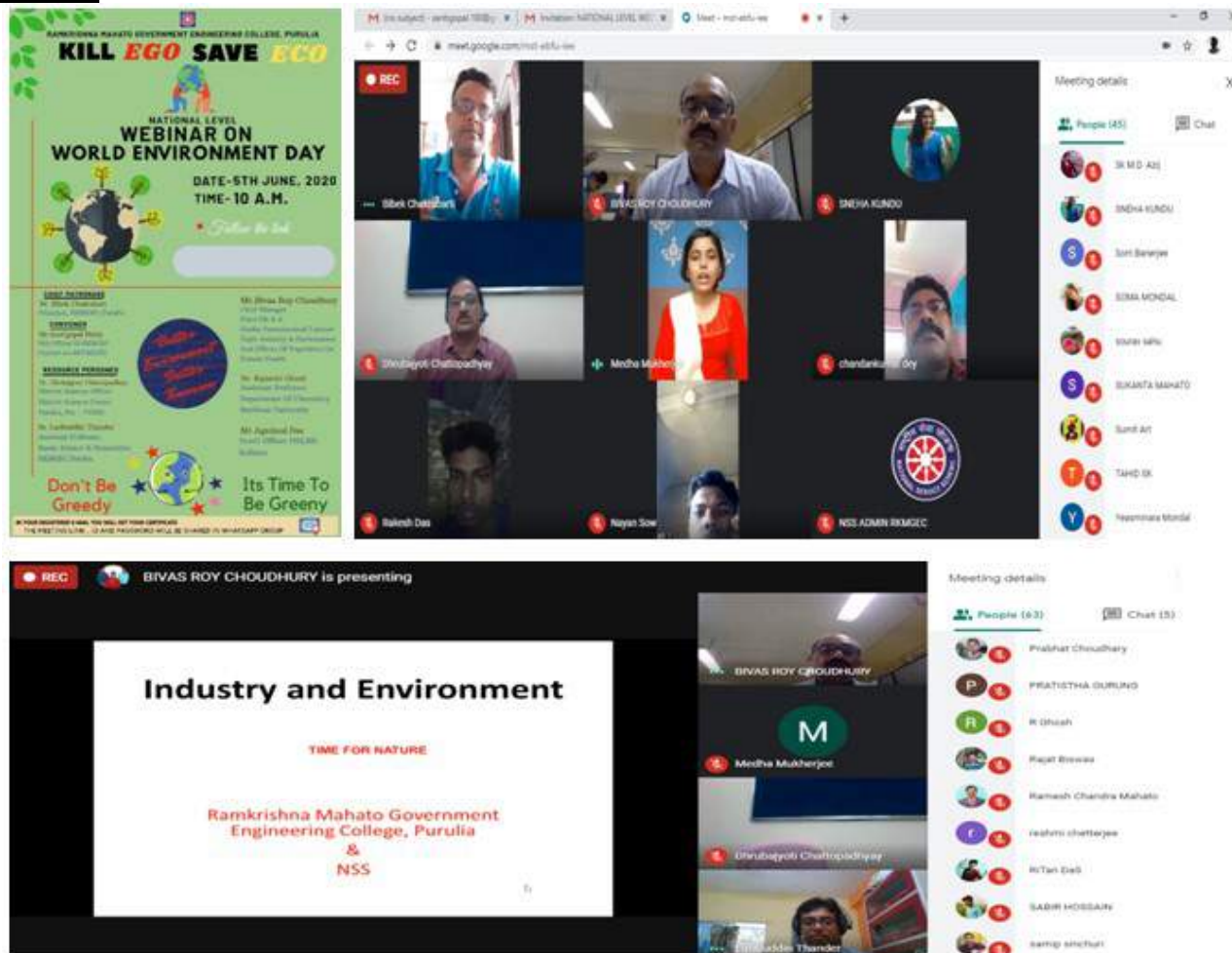


Event Name: National Webinar on World Environment Day

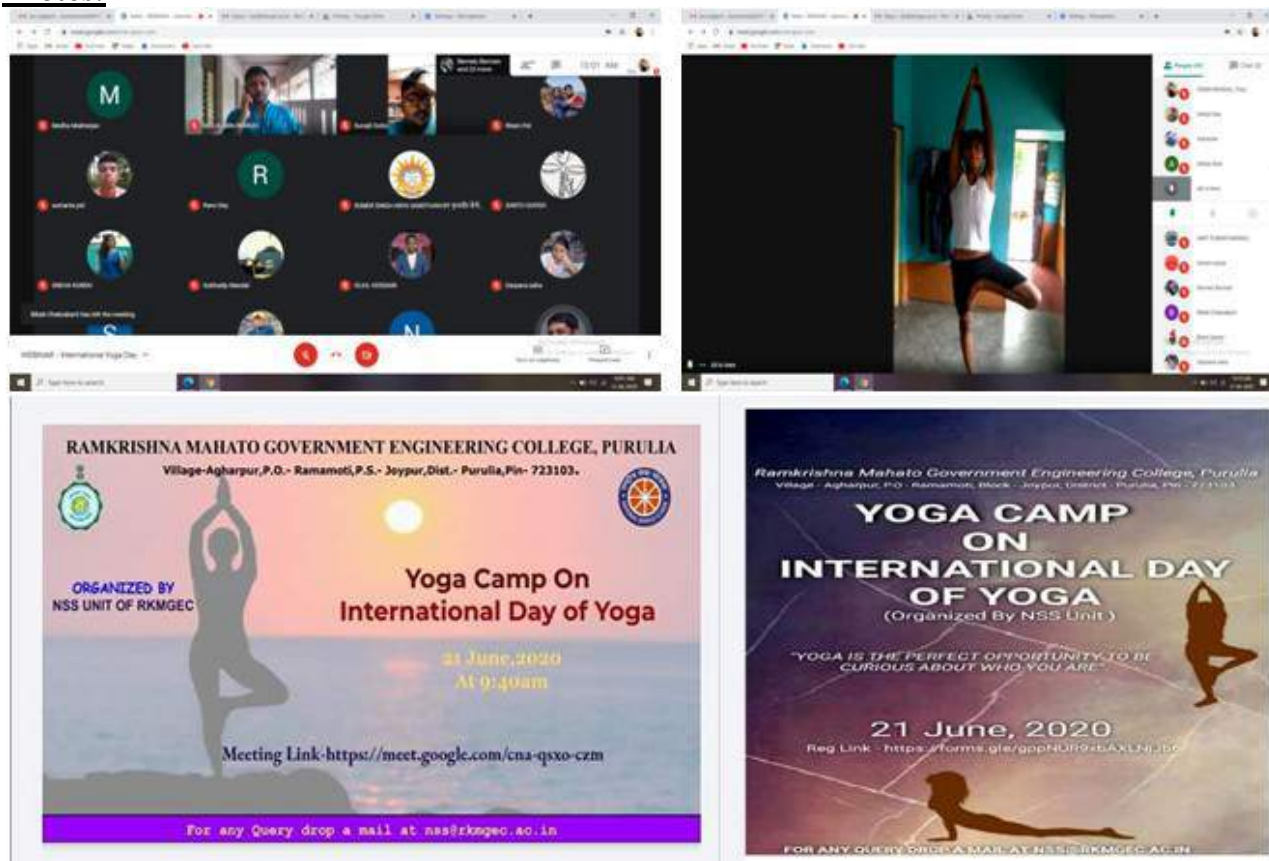

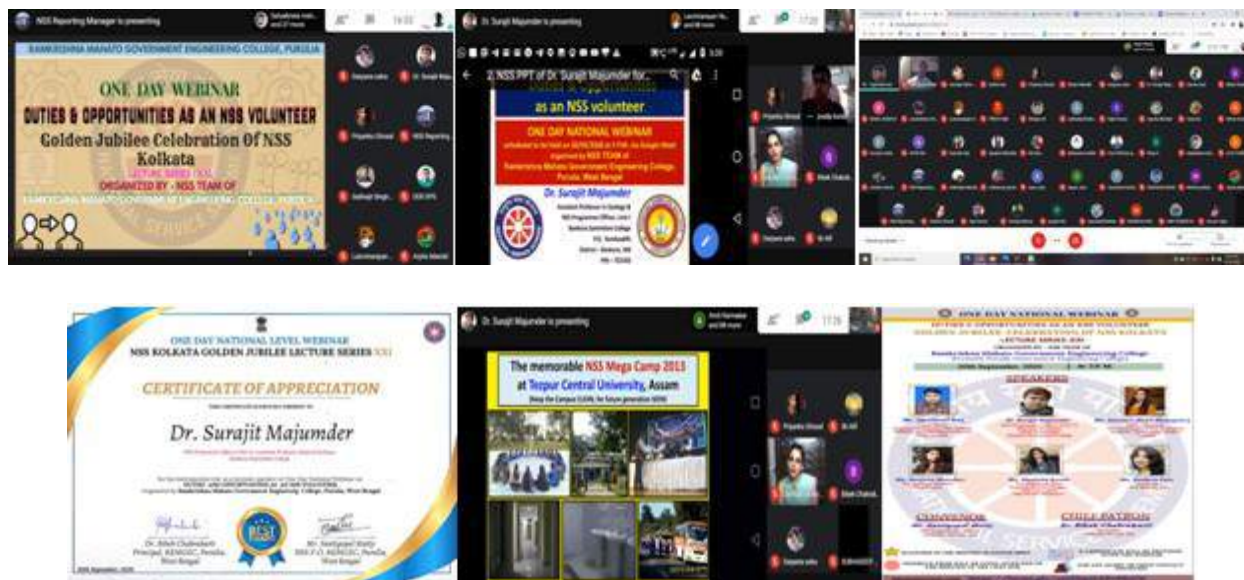
